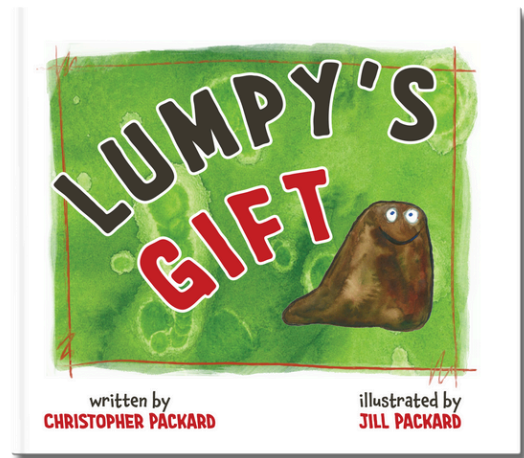


Lumpy's Gift
